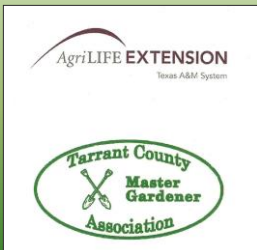

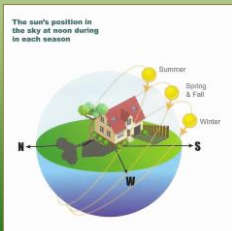


Shady Transformations



Considerations...

Light Conditions



Part Shade - dappled light, less than 5 hours direct sun (a.m./p.m.)

Full Shade - bright, but no direct sun
 texture (small, fine or large, bold)
 foliage color, variation
 look (weeping, upright, etc.)
 height/width (flower size)
 recommended spacing
 fragrance
 shade tolerant
 native/Adapted
 growth habit

Embrace the shade; don't overprune
